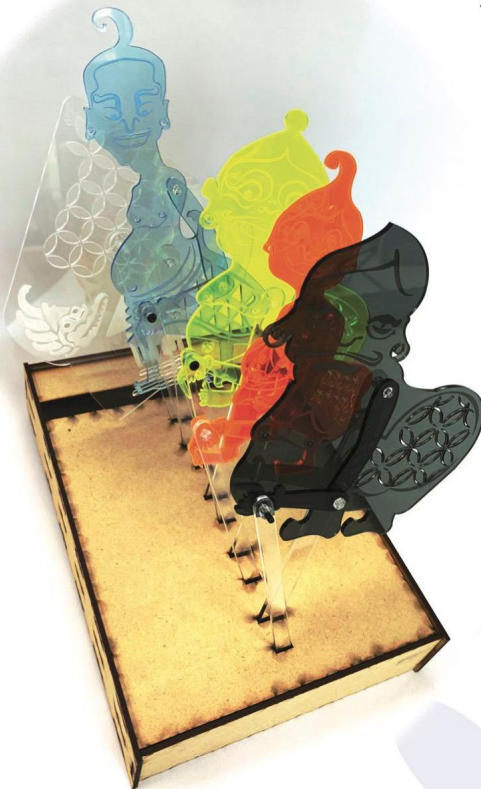
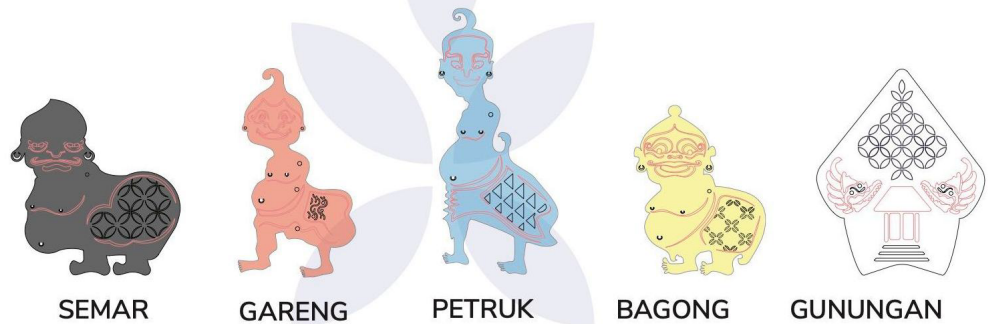
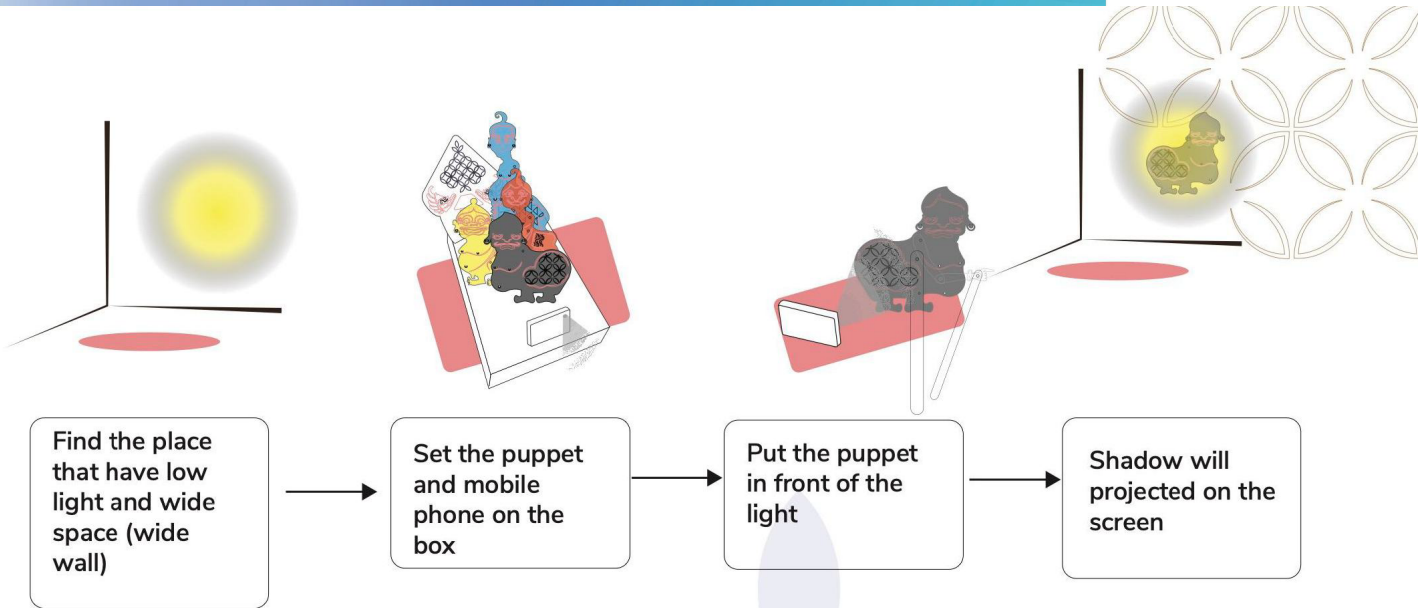


THE PANAKAWAN: SHADOW PUPPET SHOW SET

The Panakawan Shadow Puppet Show Set was made with Acrylic and MDF. This toy set puppet can be used by teachers and parents who want to give shadow puppet storytelling for the kids. The Panakawan puppet set can be used as a decorative element at home.

This toy set, adapted from wayang or shadow puppet, was initially introduced to Indonesian society (known as Nusantara in that era) around 35 C.E. by merchants from India. Shadow puppet was a popular entertainment at that time.

In this toy set, the characters of panakawan consist of the famous four: Semar, Bagong, Gareng, and Petruk. Each of them symbolizes the character of the noble person and is represented by different colors to represent each character.

Players are able to use their own flashlight with any colors to show different colors of shadow other than black.

As a set, the box was designed to fit all the puppets to put inside, including the flashlight.
