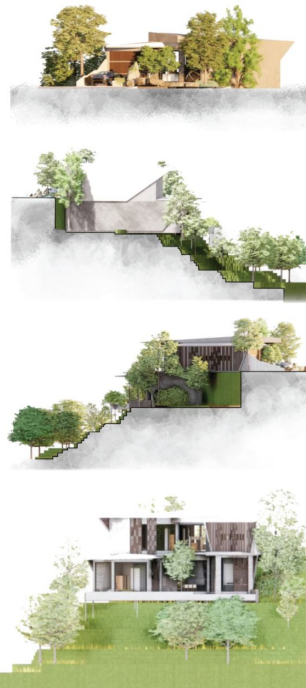




SERENITH

the nurse needs to stay close to the stroke patient.

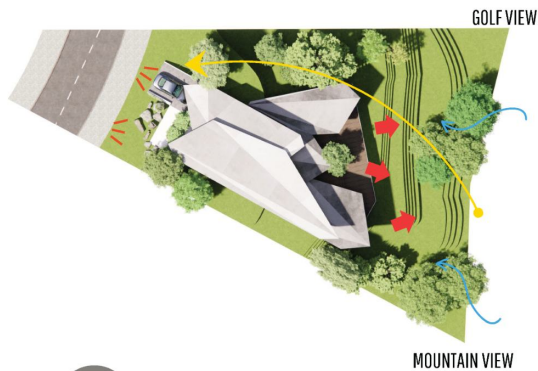


a space that is sufficient for circulation and therapy.

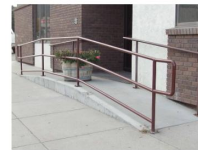
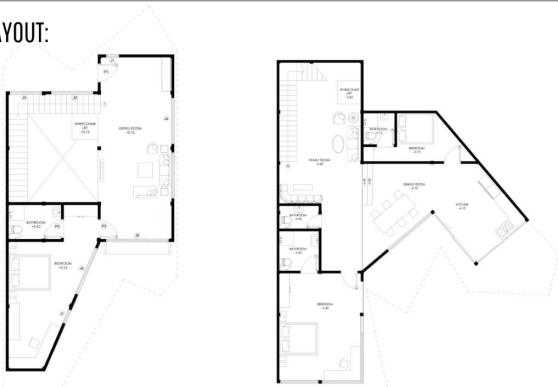


provide calm and relaxation to avoid boredom and stress.

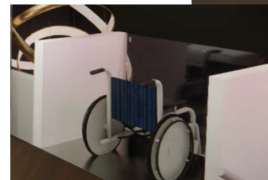
SITE ANALYSIS:



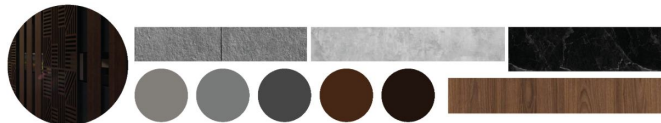
LAYOUT:

- the nurse's room must be close to the stroke patient to ensure easier access.



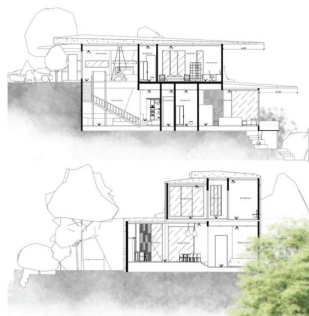
